CALL FOR POSTER ABSTRACTS

The Sino-America Biotechnology and Pharmaceutical Professional Association (SABPA, www.sabpa.org) invites abstracts for posters to be presented at the SABPA OC/LA 12th Annual Biomedical Forum in Irvine on April 29, 2017 (Saturday). SABPA will provide an opportunity at this meeting for original scholarly work on biomedical, pharmaceutical and related research to be presented in a poster format for up to 8 posters.

The Annual Biomedical Forum is one of the flagship events organized by SABPA OC/LA. There will be two keynote speakers for the upcoming 12th annual forum: 2016 MacArthur Fellow Professor Jin-Quan Yu, a synthetic chemist pioneering new techniques for the functionalization of carbon-hydrogen (C-H) bonds, and Dr. Lee E. Babiss, CEO of X-Rx Inc., a Carlyle and Hellman & Friedman-majority owned Biotech. The event participants will include scientists, entrepreneurs, and hiring managers from local pharmaceutical, medical device and CRO companies as well as well-known professors, research scientists and students from local universities, and representatives from China Life Science Technology Park and other China venture capital investors.

Submission Requirement

- Poster abstracts may be submitted by undergraduate, graduate students, postdoctoral fellows or research scientists involved in the fields of biomedical and pharmaceutical research.
- Abstracts are limited to 300 words in length including title and should contain the following sections: Objective, Methods, Results, Conclusions.
- The abstract should be clear, concise, and free of graphs, tables, and illustrations.
- <u>Abstracts for posters previously presented at other forums/meetings within this past year may be</u> <u>submitted for consideration</u> (please submit only the abstract and not the poster).
- Abstract or poster submissions should be sent to SABPA (sabpa.ocla@gmail.com).
- All abstracts will be selected through a peer-review process by Forum Committee.
- The author for accepted abstract must register and attend the meeting to present. The author also understands and consents to SABPA electronically post the abstract online or publish in printed materials. The author is responsible for providing the abstract in a print-ready form.

Meeting Information

- Top 8 abstracts will each receive two complimentary registrations to the meeting. The rest of top 20 abstracts will each receive one complimentary registration to the meeting.
- All abstract submissions will be sent meeting brochure and be invited to attend the meeting.
- There will be one <u>Best Poster Award</u>, which will be voted by all meeting attendees on the meeting day. The award will be presented at the meeting.
